

## Christine Knapp's Recommended Supply List

All of the supplies below can be purchased from: [www.SculptureDepot.net](http://www.SculptureDepot.net)

- Caliper 6" long
- Acacia Wood tools #37A, 29A, 4B
- Double wire loop tool (Serrated loop tool) # 211 (or 210 if first tool is out of stock)
- Sanded Wooden board onto which you can attach your armature and clay. Make sure it is two inches larger than the planned length and width of your sculpture.
- Glyptic "E" handle with set of 4 small loops to fit handle-OPTIONAL
- modeling/wax tool #21X- OPTIONAL
- Black indelible marker
- Needle-nosed pliers
- Black electrical tape
- Armature wire-

1/8 diameter for small sculptures

3/16 diameter for medium sculptures

- 14" tall armature (back iron) as needed. (not all sculpture needs an armature)  
This size back iron could be used for a sculpture up to 18" high.
- Oil based clay. I recommend cream colored Chavant Le Beau Touche HM clay – 3-6 two-pound blocks, depending on the size of your sculpture.
- Sturdy Cardboard box big enough to ship or transport your sculpture home or to a foundry. I will help you cut it down to size as needed.
- Packing tape for your shipping box

Christine will also have extra assorted tools available for student use: needle-nosed pliers, hammer, drill, screws & rubber bands, electrical tape (for armature), clay cutters, black indelible markers, glue gun. A limited number of 2 LB clay blocks (chavant le beau touche) will also be available for purchase through Christine if needed. She will also have a small microwave available to warm the clay.
