Materials List

Water Color Class

You will need:

- . 1" artists tape
 - 1 - Size #12 round sable watercolor brush
 - 1 - Size #12 or #14 flat sable or synthetic sable watercolor brush
 - 1 - Butcher's Tray Palette. 7" x 11" (A round white dinner plate also works fine. About 12 inches across.)
 - 1 - Watercolor Block Paper, Cold Press, 140 wt, 10 x 7", or 9" x 12". (20 sheets)
 - 1 - Watercolor Block Paper, Hot Press, 140 wt, 10 x 7", or 9" x 12". (20 sheets)
 - 1 - Reusable plastic container for water
 - 1 - Small container to wash out your brush. (This could be a re-used yogurt cup or an old drinking cup.)
 - 1 - Roll of Paper towels.
 - 1 - Small spray bottle or atomizer.
 - 1 - Plastic garbage bag or reusable trash bag.

- Ultramarine Blue
- Cerulean Blue
- Yellow Ocher
- Cadmium Yellow Light, (or Cadmium Lemon)
- Cadmium Red Light (or Cadmium Scarlet)
- Alizarin Crimson
- Winsor Green
- Sap Green
- Cadmium Orange
- Cadmium Yellow Deep
